The kitchen crew—PSMP **Penny LaChapelle** and SMVP **BJ Lebeck** from Peters Creek #4174

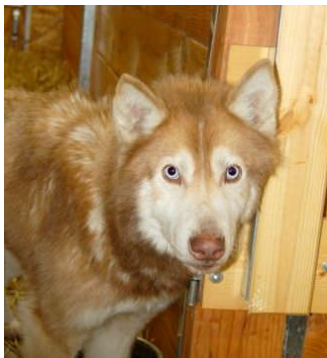
