Step 1:

Independent Wrestlers: Fax your completed and signed registration form by the deadlines above and pay the entry fee(s) at appropriate registration time.

Club Coordinators: If you do not turn in your club packet before or at the Avalanche Tournament, EACH PARTICIPANTS ENTRY FORM AND YOUR TEAM ROSTER **MUST BE FAXED** to Jeanette Perkins. Team rosters (participants only) must include each competitor's name, DATE OF BIRTH, age division, USAW card number, and style(s) they are wrestling. Teams are encouraged to meet the pre-registration deadline. Please make your club check for all your entrants payable to Alaska USA Wrestling which can be delivered in your packet or at registration if you have late registrants.

Step 2: After you have submitted the entry form(s) and team roster (clubs only), you will need to enter all your state tournament participants online at www.trackwrestling.com. This includes independent wrestlers. At this point, most clubs are familiar with this process. If you have not done this before, please contact Jeanette Perkins at (907) 982-3051. There will be 3 separate tournaments listed so please make sure each wrestler is entered in their appropriate tournament(s). **The last day to enter any entries for the tournament is 10 pm, Wednesday, April 29, 2009.** After this date, registrations will only be accepted at registration during the published weigh-in times.

GENERAL INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: *Once competitor's registrations have been received, there will be no refunds issued for any of the styles club members or individual members have registered for (unless there are extenuating circumstances).*

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes must be a current member of Alaska USA Wrestling and meet age requirements. Alaska USA cards can be purchased for \$50.00 at the tournament. USA wrestling cardholders who purchased their cards outside of Alaska USA Wrestling will be required to pay an additional \$10 AUSAW fee.

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: Attractive medals to the top six placers in each weight class for Freestyle Tournament and to the top 3 in each weight class for the Girl's Tournament and the Greco-Roman Tournament. Medals will be awarded as soon as possible after the completion of an age group bracket for Pre-Bantams and Bantams. Medals will be awarded after the tournament for Midget – Open age groups. *The AUSAW State Tournament is Alaska's "only qualifier" for the Kids and Cadets Western Regional Team. Age group directors will be on hand to provide information about these trips.*

TEAM AWARDS: Team trophies will be awarded to the top three (highest points) teams in the Kids Division (Pre-Bantam – Schoolboy/girl) and the top three teams in the Cadet – Open Divisions. A Grand Champion (Freestyle) trophy will be awarded to the team with the highest points – Pre-Bantam through Open Divisions. This year we will have trophies for the top three teams for the Greco-Roman tournament.

RULES: The rules of FILA, with current USA Wrestling modifications where applicable, will govern the event. **Wrestlers in the Kids Division (Pre-Bantam – Schoolboy) must wear headgear.** Head gear is recommended but not mandatory for Cadets and Juniors. Wrestlers with braces must wear a mouthpiece.

WEIGH-INS: Each athlete must weigh-in at the official weigh-ins.

THURSDAY WEIGH-INS:

- **All Pre-Bantams, Bantams and Greco-Roman participants (Intermediate – Open Divisions) MUST weigh-in Thursday night** ◀
- **Note: Greco participants can also weigh-in at this time for Freestyle on Saturday** ◀

FRIDAY WEIGH-INS:

- **Intermediate – Open Freestyle Divisions wrestling on Saturday Only – NO THURSDAY WEIGH-INS** ◀

If an out of town competitor is arriving later than the official weigh-in, please advise the tournament director Ed Gravely at ed@mail.mvfcuonline.org or call (907) 745-9108.

All athletes must weigh-in wearing a competition singlet. All weigh-in cards will have a "blind" computer generated draw number printed on them so participants will not need to choose one at weigh-ins. **Competitors will be locked into the weight class they declare at the time of weigh-ins.** If a wrestler chooses to bump up a weight class, officials must be told during the competitor's weigh-in, which will be noted, on their weight card. If Pairing Officials find there is only one person in a weight class, the wrestler will have the option of medalling with an exhibition match in that weight class or he/she will be allowed to bump up to the next weight class which has more wrestlers, if applicable, as long as the competitor realizes that this weight is also the weight that he/she will qualify for at regional and/or National event. **This will be the only exception.**

PAIRINGS: Separation of wrestlers from the same club when possible. Double elimination line bracket with complete wrestle-backs to sixth place. Any bracket with six or more competitors will be pooled and cross-bracketed. The first place wrestler in the pool "A" will wrestle the first place finisher in pool "B" for 1st and 2nd place. #2 in "A" will wrestle #2 in "B" for 3rd and 4th place. #3 in "A" will wrestle #3 in "B" for 5th and 6th place.

COACHING: Two coaches' maximum in each competitor's corner on the mat during a match. Coaches **MUST** hold a current coach's card to be in a corner. Spectators or parents video taping or taking pictures will not be allowed on the mat edge – this area must be kept clear.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: Athletes must be prepared to submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh-in. The Head Official has full authority without appeal in determining the eligibility of an athlete to compete. In the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Head Official and Tournament Director, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.

MATS, TIMING & SCORING TABLE WORKERS: Each Age Division will be assigned specific mats during the tournament. **ALL CLUBS ARE REQUIRED TO MAN A TABLE (scorer, timer and towel tapper) DURING THE TOURNAMENT.** AUSAW needs every club to participate in order to keep the mats running in a timely manner. Smaller clubs will be paired with larger clubs. Thank you in advance for your cooperation! Note: When possible, officials will run 3-man mat mechanics which includes one of them scoring.

TOURNAMENT T-SHIRTS / CONCESSIONS / OFFICIALS HOSPITALITY ROOM: State tournament t-shirts will be available for sale both days. A concession stand will be available both days. There will be a hospitality room for officials and admittance will only be allowed to those wearing officials' shirts. There will also be a room available that teams can use for a coaches hospitality room.
