Camp Dates

The Camp will start on 5 July 2009 at Noon on Bartlett High School's track. It is recommended that if you will be staying with a Host Family that you show up the Day prior to get with Coach Ritchie and get set up. The Host housing will have been pre-arranged and you will know ahead of time who you will stay with. The last day of camp is the 16th of July after the 2nd session. You will be given 1 day to go home and meet up at Anchorage Airport for Nationals.

Cost

The Cost of the Camp will be \$350.00 for commuters and \$500 for persons staying at Host Families. This will cover the living area, meals and technicians. You will receive 1 Team Alaska T-Shirt at camp. All National Team members will receive there Uniforms at no cost. Cost of Nationals is separate from the camp and will be processed differently. 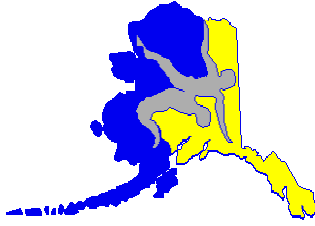
IN CONSIDERATION FOR the opportunity to participate in the EVENT described below, PARTICIPANTS acknowledge, agrees and affirms the following.

1. The following words used in this document will have the meaning indicated:
 - A. "EVENT" shall mean the **USAW Cadet and Junior Nationals/ "Future of Champions Camp" National Prep Camp**
 - B. "AUSAW" shall mean Alaska USA Wrestling, and its directors, officers, members, official, committees, affiliates, agents and the successors and assigns
 - C. "EVENT ORGANIZER" shall mean a club, local organizing committee or any other person or entity responsible for hosting, conducting, and /or sponsoring the EVENT, including my director, officer, member, official, committee, or agent thereof and their successors and assigns.
 - D. "PARTICIPANT" shall mean the undersigned individual who competes or is involved in the EVENT and his/her parents, legal guardians, heirs, personal representatives and their successors and assigns.
 - E. "PERSONAL INJURY" shall mean and include any bodily injury" permanent, temporary, total or partial disability" paralysis; dismemberment ; or death.
 - F. "PROPERTY DAMAGE" shall mean and include damage or destruction to PARTICIPANTS gear equipment and all other personal property or belongings.
 - G. "MEDICAL TREATMENT " shall mean and include all emergency medical treatment, medical procedures, hospitalization or other care rendered to PARTICIPANT in connection with or resulting from his/her participation in EVENT.
 - H. "LOSS" shall mean and include any and all liabilities, losses, damages and claims (including reasonable costs and attorneys' fees). Which are suffered or result directly or indirectly from PERSONAL INJURY , PROPERTY DAMAGE and/or MEDICAL TREATMENT to PARTICIPANT, or others, and which are incurred during or in the course of PARTICIPANT'S preparation for, participation and involvement in, and travel to or from the EVENT or the conduct and management of the EVENT.
2. By issuing a sanction for the EVENT, AUSAW is not responsible or liable for the management or conduct of the EVENT, unless AUSAW has otherwise expressly agreed in writing to serve in such role.
3. PARTICIPANT understands and appreciates the risks of serious injury that may occur in the sport of wrestling or in the course of preparing for, participating in and traveling in or from the EVENT, and that such activities may involve risks, including PERSONAL INJURY.
4. PARTICIPANT knowingly and voluntarily assumes all such risks of LOSS and all legal and financial responsibility therefore.
5. PARTICIPANT releases, waives any claims and promises not to sue the EVENT ORGANIZER and/or AUSAW with respect to any LOSS incurred during or in connection with his/her participation in the EVENT, any activities associated with the EVENT and the conduct and management of the EVENT (including as many result from the negligence of the EVENT ORGANIZER), except any LOSS which is the result of gross negligence and/or willful or wanton misconduct by the EVENT ORGANIZER. PARTICIPANT further agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the EVENT ORGANIZER and/or AUSAW from any claims brought against the EVENT ORGANIZER and/or AUSAW resting from, arising out of or in any way associated with any LOSS.
6. Prior to participating in the EVENT, PARTICIPANT shall have the right to inspect the facilities and equipment to be used and, if PARTICIPANT discovers any condition which he/she reasonable believes to be unsafe, PARTICIPANT will immediately cause EVENT officials to be notified of such condition and will not participate in the EVENT so long as such condition exists.

4. I have read and agree to the Athletes Agreement on the official tournament entry form, and agree to abide to the rules and regulations of USA Wrestling.

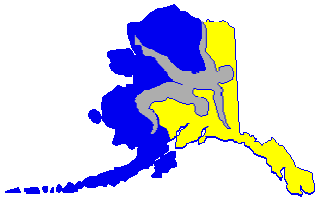

Sponsorship

To Whom It May Concern:

Team Alaska would like to ask you for a sponsorship request from you and your company. This is a great opportunity for you to help an athlete gain the skills to be successful at the National level. They will learn training work ethics and the fundamental techniques needed for this level of wrestling. Since 6 years ago Team Alaska has had 3 National Champions and several All-Americans. Team Alaska has had a higher percent of All American than most states that compete and with your help we can continue to do that.

Over the past years Team Alaska has grown more competitively at the National level, but with growth of the team the cost to fund the team has grown as well. Your sponsorship would help offset the cost of attending this camp for many of our athletes in the state of Alaska. The ages of our wrestlers range from 13yrs to 18yrs old. This will also cover the cost of there National uniforms and will defer the cost of highly qualified technicians.

Head Coach Mark Lane is currently the Head Coach of Kotzebue High School. He is a former NAIA National Champion and 3 x All-American for Montana State-Northern. This will be Mark's first year as the Head Coach of the National Team.

Coach Eli Hutchison is a returning Team Alaska Coach. He is a 7 x All American, 2 x National Finalist, 1x National Champion with Team Alaska, and a 4 x Alaska State Champ. He is currently is on his 3rd year as a Boise State Division 1 Wrestler at 141lbs.

Coach Kaylen Baxter is a returning Team Alaska Coach. He is a 5 x All American in both Freestyle and Greco Roman with Team Alaska and a 3 x Alaska State Champ. He currently on his 3rd year of Wrestling for Division 1 Old Dominion University with a second year winning record and was rank in the top 20 in the Nation at 149lbs.

Coach Hollan Gravely is an All American in Freestyle and Greco Roman for Team Alaska and 4 x Alaska State Champ. He is currently wrestling Division II at Western State College at 141lbs.

Coach Travis Harrison, a prior Team Oregon Coach and 2 x Oregon State Champ. He is a 2 x All American in Freestyle and Greco Roman with Team Oregon. He was also a Junior World Team member in Greco Roman.

With this Letter you should also receive a letter from that wrestler seeking sponsorship telling a little about his history, short term and long term goals. These wrestlers are specially selected to represent the state at Nationals and he or she will remain in touch with you and let you know how he did with photos of them at Nationals.
